Accessible: data & metadata can be accessed appropriately & responsibly




Interoperable: data are interoperable with diverse applications, systems & stores




Reusable: data & metadata are well-described to enable repeated use

Species Records











Data interoperability enables diverse data applications




Understanding of environmental status & change


